



Board Policy Related to Compliance with NAEC Guidelines Adopted September 25, 2012

Background: The NAEC Board approved a new policy regarding compliance with the standards in the NAEC Guidelines for member centers. Centers complete a Center Designation Annual Report to be designated as a level 3 or 4 center each year. Some centers do not fully complete the report and/or report data inconsistent with their designation level. This policy explains the process for handling reports with incomplete or inconsistent data.

Policy – Grace Period to Comply with NAEC Guidelines: Centers that submit annual reports that are incomplete or show that they do not meet specific standards included in the NAEC Guidelines for a specific center designation level will have a one-year grace period to come into compliance. If they do not comply by the second year, they will not be designated by NAEC.
